A color can be specified in a hexadecimal value or by its name.

Despite the fact that you can specify any color for the background, most sites use primarily a white background and black letters as the most wellestablished option.

Wallpaper

As a background, you can use any image suitable for this. The background should not distract attention from the text, it should be well combined with the color scheme of the web page and be small in size to load quickly. If after the above you still want to add a background image to the page, you should use the attribute background Tera<body>.

If the image is smaller than the size of the monitor screen, it will be multiplied horizontally and vertically.

Since the background image loads more slowly than the background color, it may turn out that the text will not be read for some time until the images are loaded. The same thing can happen when drawings are disabled in the browser. Therefore, it is recommended that you always set the background color along with the background pattern (Example 3).

If you specify the bgproperties attribute, as shown in Example 4, the background image on the web page will remain stationary, and the text, images, and other elements will begin to move along with the scroll bar.
